



Teaching English, Sports, Life Skills

Aim:

Prepare and teach with our Cambodian staff, support them with your knowledge and organise additional activities for the students (e.g. project weeks).

Our focus is on cooperative learning strategies and playful, creative lessons, so as to raise the student's knowledge and to enable them to have the courage to develop their own ideas and to become self-confident.

Specific Requirements:

- Available for 3 months (preferably 6 months)
- Experienced in teaching, experience in the field of education
- Teaching degree, minimum TEFL (or similar) for English teaching
- Capable of expressing yourself in good English, spoken and written
- Willing to work mornings and evenings with a long lunch/afternoon break

Job Descriptions:

English:

The students you will be teaching range from 9-22 years old, and are typically in groups of 15-25 students per class. You will prepare weekly lesson plans together with the teacher (2 hours per day, usually in the morning). In the late afternoon and evening you will assist and teach 4 lessons per day from Monday to Friday.

We mainly work with www.readinga-z.com, *Let's Go* and *New Hotline* series.

Library:

Creativity, a love of children and team spirit are necessary to work with our students and staff. Students are free to join the library hours when they choose. You will organise and conduct reading clubs, reading activities, movie shows, reading comprehension and recreational activities (painting, drawing, singing...) together with the librarian.

You will support the librarians with the registration of the books and games.

Football:

Are you talented in football or do you know other sports? You can assist our staff to run sports at our schools. Train our staff in coaching our football teams (12 and under, 15 and under, 17 and under) and coach the teams together with the staff on Sundays. From January till March there is the Siem Reap Soccer Tournament on Sundays in which we participate.



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Life Skills and Career Training:

Work alongside our Life Skills and Career Trainer to teach our students about Social Education, Careers and Jobs, Health etc.

Lessons take place on Saturday afternoons and early evenings.

Before coming to Cambodia you will exchange ideas with the local staff members and work out your plan. During your stay you are expected to cooperate with the local staff and report on work on a regular basis. The staff will support you during your volunteer time and help you to set up a working schedule.
