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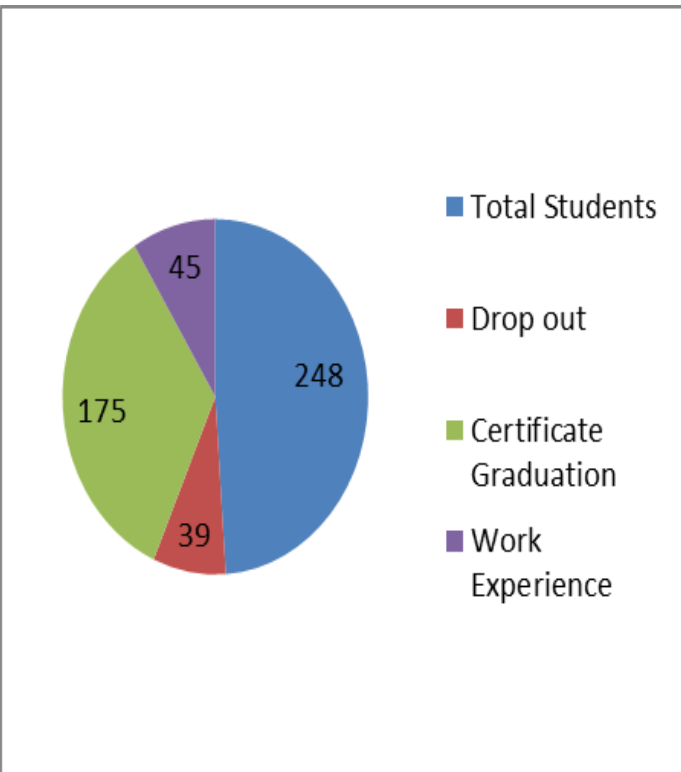

Thus, we would like to share with you the annual report for 2015.

Programs

English project



English Classes: There were twelve English classes with 248 students applied to study with Salariin Kampuchea. There were 39 students left school because of they were busy with public schools, having jobs, and helping house work.

Certificate and Graduation: 175 certificates were offered to the students who graduated from Let’s Go 3, 6, and New Headway Elementary within the academic year 2015. The graduation and certificate party was celebrated for the successful students during Pchum Ben farewell party in October.

Student engagement: During the year, our staff, teachers and students come with ideas to install English class’s ceiling in order to protect heat from the sun while they are learning in class. They did build the ceiling together and we were certified for their support and help.

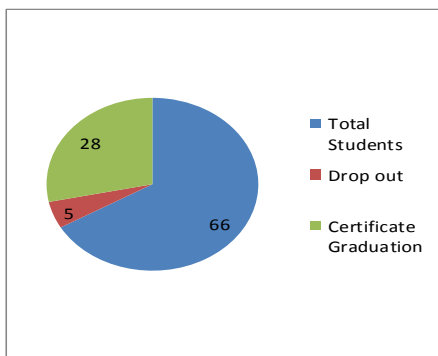
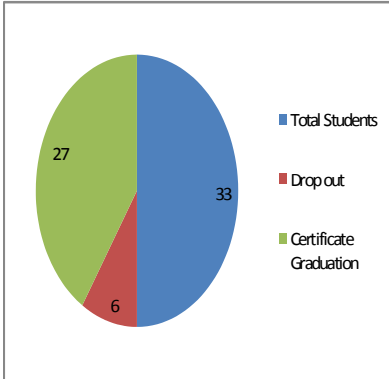
Competition and outcome: Over 200 students participate in Spelling Bee; 6 students win and get reward. 45 students got part-time employment with Pacific Hotel during December.

Basic Hygiene: Over 200 students participated in Hand Washing and tooth brushing project.



Life skill project

During the year of 2015, there were 33 students enrolled for the 4th generation of life skill program. There were 27 graduated successfully. Our enthusiastic Life Skills Students visited different hotels as well as the Youth Employment Service (YES) in Siem Reap to get a better idea of how a hotel operates in a busy tourist centre and to get career guidelines, to gain some experience in a variety of jobs as well as to improve access to employment information. With the boom of tourism in the town there are good opportunities for young adults in Salariin Kampuchea wanting to work in the hotel industry in the future.



Computer Project

66 students attended in the course during the year of 2015. 28 graduated successfully from MS. Word, Excel, internet and email students. Currently 37 students are studying in basic computer MS. Word and Ms. Excel. 5 students dropped out during the year because of extra class at state schools, and work.

Library project

During the year our librarians conducted different activities with not only our school students but with other children and teenagers from the surrounding communities. Reading club, reading comprehension, movie show, folding pictures and drawing, playing different games were popular for external and internal students. Throughout the year, on average, 54 students come to each library time. It increases than last year.

Football project

We have had another very successful footballing year of 2015 at S.K. Students from our school participated in the Globalteer Junior Soccer League in Siem Reap. All teams played fantastically, growing in confidence and showing real team spirit throughout. With help from our supporter, Jorn, four football teams have continued, four teams, Under 10 years, Under 13 years, Under 14 years (For girl team), Under 16 years.



Scholarship and sponsorship

In 2015, we have supported 8 adult from Salariin Kampuchea has received scholarship to study at university in Siem Reap and Phnom Penh from the [Chance2Study](#) organization, and individual sponsors. There are six students are now sponsored by [Chance2Study](#).

Other two students are still being sponsored by individual sponsor to study in universities at Phnom Penh.

There are three students get a one year vocational training at Haven restaurant in Siem Reap.

- Our teachers and educational volunteer discuss and develop our teaching tool and certificate test development as well as improve the library.

Staff, volunteers and students celebrated New Year and Pchum Ben party as well as certificate graduation parties. They were very cheerful and enjoyable with traditional games and dancing. They were fantastic and fun.

Spelling Competitions

Students from different classes at school spent several months completing a series of spelling courses to improve their knowledge and understanding in English. The Spelling Bee program culminated in a competition between the ten classes in the school, held at our school in Chreav. It was a great day, bringing the ten classes together to learn and socialize. Students showed enthusiasm and real team spirit in their support of one another throughout the program.



Puppet Workshop and Parade Night

There were around 30 students, staff and volunteers participated in the giant puppet workshop and parade night organized by the Giant Puppet project in Siem Reap. They really enjoy it.

Achievement

- We have continued school and run our projects with projects and activities above.
- 8 SK students are currently continued support at universities and three students get one year vocational training at Haven Restaurant.
- 45 students got work experience to work at Pacific hotels.
- In October 2015, 175 certificates were offered to English, computer and life skill students for their graduation during the party.
- Traffic police officer offered a workshop for 60 young adult students about traffic law and policies.
- Our former student conducted a cooking lesson to share to our life skill students.

Challenges

With sort of fund for 2015, we short of human resource so we promote part time accountant to a full time staff to work as assistance of director. We tried cut down some costs and made each budget lines from different projects lower. Furthermore, we worked with our fundraising consultant and volunteer to look for new donors. Our director contacted and asked different previous volunteers and donors to fulfill the missing gap of budget.

Drop out students still happening in the school even though we support them and encourage them as they were busy with their state schools and some of them got job. However, based on

our experience we should work closely with parents as well as support students whose parents and themselves want to learn and participate in our programs.
